Core and Pedagogy Requirements

The Masters Program is a 38 credit hour program, including 11 hours of core course in research and educational research, 9 hours in pedagogical content, and 18 hours in one of seven concentrations (Instructional Technology, Special Education, Music, Education, Linguistically Diverse Education, Physical Education, Foreign Language, Art Education). The four core courses are developmental, with the first taken within the first nine hours, the third within the last nine hours, and the final course completed as the capstone experience in the program.
